Dear Member,

The 4 year process is still going smoothly and has been extended to our clubs this year. The certifying criteria haven't changed and renewal forms are only being sent to those whose cards have expired or who haven't been certified by us this year. You can, of course, still be certified by your local club but please remember to carry your card with you at all times on MoD and Bisley ranges. We have had incidents where we have had to turn people away who didn't have their club issued cards and we really don't want to do that.

If you certified via one of our assessment days, then that will qualify you to re-certify this year (as long as the assessment was within the last 12 months) and we must receive the renew request paperwork within twelve months of your certification date. If it is more than a year old you will be invited to attend another assessment day. Please note that those shooting 7(3) firearms are classified under short range pistol and can renew their cards automatically as well, with the same constrictions.

You will find the renewal request form attached. If you need to attend a certification day, you can book online via our website, www.nra.org.uk, or by contacting Sarah Wells on the number or email quoted above.

If you now need additional categories on your card you must show that on the renewal request in order to get them all on the one card. You can also be certified by other clubs you belong to (assuming they affiliate to us) but you would then need to carry two or more cards.

If you do have an email address but have received this as a paper copy, please email me on memsec@nra.org.uk so that I can update your records.
