AIM

As a perfect precursor to the busy Gallery Rifle competition season, the NRA is offering a Gallery Rifle Competition Coaching Day at FDPC's new range complex in Shepton Mallet, proudly sponsored by the NRA.

This day allows the unique opportunity to be coached by members of the Great Britain Gallery Rifle squad and will give attendees the opportunity to improve marksmanship and confidence by being individually coached through the various aspects of the 1500 Gallery Rifle match. The first opportunity to shoot this match is the NRA Spring Action Weekend, Bisley, 25-26 March.

The day is open to all NRA members including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess the appropriate firearm, but have successfully completed the required probationary course. Non-NRA members can attend providing they possess the appropriate firearm and pay the additional membership fee.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £50.00. Ammunition and firearms are not included and attendees are expected to arrange, or bring their own.

Those wanting to loan an appropriate rifle, please tick the box on the attached form.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should bring warm clothing and appropriate footwear. Although the range is indoors the air temperature with extractors running can get quite cool. You will need:

- Ear defenders
- Appropriate firearm or firearms, GRFC, GRSB, LBR, LBP
- Appropriate amount of ammunition - at least 500 rounds for the day
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil

Tea and coffee will be available, however the range does not have facilities for lunch. There are local shops, or please bring a packed lunch.

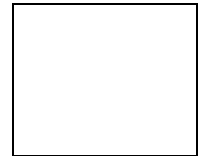
