NRA TARGET SHOTGUN SKILLS DEVELOPMENT COURSE

SATURDAY 18 FEBRUARY 2017

AIM

The Target Shotgun (TS) Skills Development Course will provide the fundamental skills for taking part in TS events and competitions, and will include individual coaching of positional shooting techniques. The course is open to full NRA members and Non-NRA members who belong to a Home Office Approved Club or have a FAC and pay the additional Non-NRA Member Fee of £6.60.

The course will involve both classroom and practical range work with expert coaching from national and international level shooters.

SHOOTER CERTIFICATION CARD (SCC) – NRA MEMBERS ONLY

This will be available if pre-booked - there is no additional fee for this however you will need to revise the NRA Target Shotgun Manual prior to attending the course as there is a written test to complete and pass.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £71.50, which includes range fees, targets, individual coaching and lunch. Ammunition and firearms are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own.

Those not yet in possession of a firearm will be lent a suitable shotgun (not FAC rated) and purchase Section 2 ammunition.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

Attendees should bring warm and weatherproof clothing and appropriate footwear in case of inclement weather. You will need:

- Safety glasses
- Ear defenders
- Firearm - a magazine fed shotgun (tube or box) either S1 or S2*
- Approximately 100 rounds of Birdshot (max size UK 4s, Fibre wads only) and 30 slug (if permitted to possess)
- Cartridge belt
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil

* note that under the Firearms Act you are NOT permitted to borrow or use a high capacity firearm or solid slug ammunition without possessing a FIREARMS licence that permits you to possess such items.

Please be advised that you will be shooting prone and the ground may be muddy. Assistance in resetting targets and clearing spent cases is mandatory.

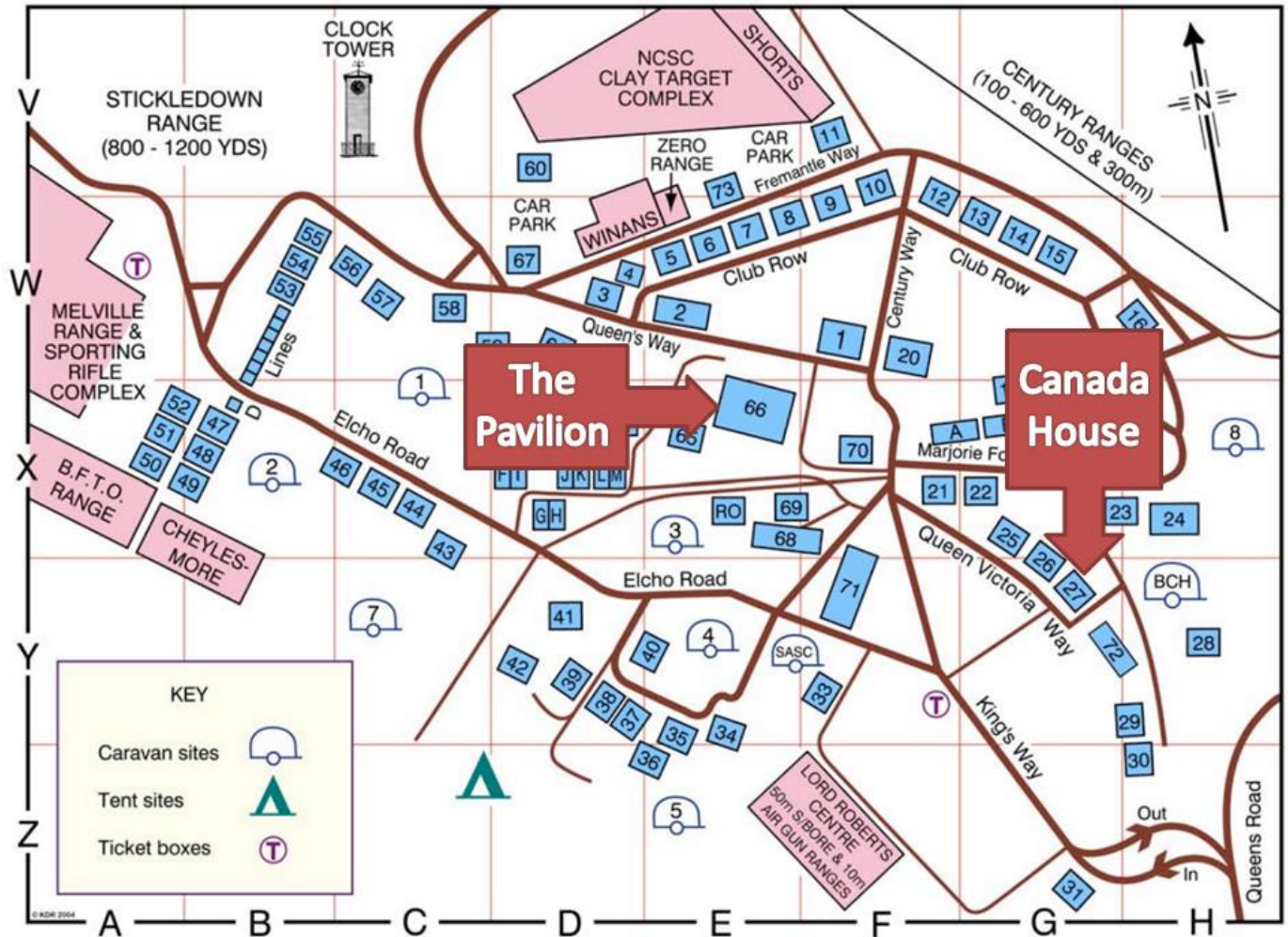
