

City Rifle Club Open Prize Meeting 2010

1. Open to any member of a Rifle Club affiliated to the N.R.A.
2. N.R.A. regulations will govern the meeting except where otherwise stated.
3. Any target rifle conforming to N.R.A TR rule 150 or any F class rifle conforming to N.R.A. rule 164 may be used. Service Rifles conforming to N.R.A. Service Rifle rules. Iron sights only. Optical sights may be used on Service Rifles but shall be deemed to be shot for honours only.
4. Any commercial ammunition may be used but must conform to CIPP and NRA regulations. 'F' class competitors may use safe hand-loads.
5. Sighters are convertible.
6. Competitors will commence shooting at the range nominated on their squadding cards.
7. Range competitions: N.R.A. rules apply.
8. Aggregate competitions: N.R.A. rules apply.
9. Score cards and claim tickets will be available from the City Clubhouse from 0730 on Saturday.
10. N.R.A. classification for the current year shall apply. No competitor will be allowed to compete as a tyro if they have previously won any prize in any open meeting.
11. The committee reserves the right to amend the rules and vary the prize list according to entries received. In the event of any dispute the decision of the committee shall be final.
12. All entries shall be deemed as acceptable unless the entrant is advised to the contrary in writing or by email. No receipts or confirmations will be issued. Entry fees must accompany the completed entry forms and should reach the Competition Secretary by 26th August. Late entries will only be accepted if target space is available.
13. All challenges must be made within one hour of results being posted.
14. Prize Giving will be in the Clubhouse at approximately 1400 on Sunday.
