

**Sunday Morning 2 April 2017      START TIME 08.00**  
**Assemble at the 300-yard car park on the RHS of Century Range**

**AM - THE IMPERIAL MATCH (Long Range Practices)**

**Stage 1 - 600x Snap**

- Distance            600 yards
- Position            Prone
- Rounds             2 sighting shots and 10 to count
- Targets             1 x Triple Fig 11
- Scoring             5 on the central target for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 elsewhere on the centre target, and 2 for a hit anywhere on the outer targets.
- Procedure
  1. Firers will have 2 minutes for sighting shots. After spotting discs have been shown, firers will be ordered to remain in the prone position, load with 10 rounds and make ready.
  2. The targets will make five appearances of 8 seconds at irregular intervals. Firers will fire two rounds per exposure.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

**Stage 2 - 500x Harrassing Fire**

- Distance            500 yards
- Position            Prone
- Rounds             10 to count (Two magazines of five)
- Targets             1 x Triple Fig 11
- Scoring             5 on the central target for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 elsewhere on the centre target, and 2 for a hit anywhere on the outer targets.
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position with rifles loaded, made ready, with safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds, firers are to adopt the prone position, release safety catches and open fire.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

**Stage 3 - 500-400x Rundown**

- Distance            500 & 400 yards
- Position            Prone at 500x, Sitting at 400x
- Rounds             10 to count
- Targets             1 x Triple Fig 11
- Scoring             5 on the outer targets for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 elsewhere on the outer targets, and 2 for a hit on the centre target.
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position on the 500 yards firing point, rifles loaded with 10 rounds, made ready, with safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the targets for 15 seconds, firers are to adopt the prone position, release safety catches and fire one round at each of the two outer targets.
  3. There will be a second exposure of 8 seconds during which firers are to fire one round at each of the outer targets. Firers will then be ordered to Make Safe.
  4. The 1 second 'flash' of the Triple Fig 11 target is the signal for firers to advance to the 400x firing point, adopt the sitting position and make ready.

5. 45 seconds later there will be three exposures of 8 seconds. Firers are to fire one round at each of the outer targets per exposure.
6. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

#### **Stage 4 - 400x Rapid**

- Distance            400 yards
- Position            Sitting
- Rounds             10 to count (two magazines of 5)
- Targets             1 x Triple Fig 11
- Scoring             5 on the outer targets for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 elsewhere on the outer targets, and 2 for a hit on the centre target.
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position with rifles loaded, 3 yards behind the firing point.
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds, firers are to advance to the firing point, adopt the sitting position, make ready and fire five rounds at each of the two outer targets.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

#### **Stage 5 - 400-300x Rundown**

- Distance            400 & 300 yards
- Position            Sitting at 400x, Prone at 300x
- Rounds             10 to count
- Targets             1 x Triple Fig 11 at 400, 1 x Fig 12 at 300
- Scoring             5 on the outer targets for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 elsewhere on the outer targets, and 2 for a hit on the centre target. 5 & 4 on the Fig 12 target.
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position with rifles loaded and made ready, with safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the targets for fifteen seconds, firers are to adopt the sitting position, release safety catches and fire one round at each of the outer Fig 11 targets.
  3. There will then be a further exposure of six seconds, one round to be fired at each of the outer Fig 11 targets. Firers will then be ordered to Make Safe.
  4. The 1 second 'flash' of the Fig 12 target is the signal for firers to advance to the 300 yards firing point, adopt the prone position and make ready.
  5. 45 seconds later there will be 6 exposures of three seconds, over a 2m frontage, at irregular intervals. Firers are to engage each exposure with one round.
  6. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

**PM - THE IMPERIAL MATCH (Short Range Practices)**

**Stage 6 - 300x Rapid**

- Distance            300 yards
- Position            Prone
- Rounds            10 to count (two magazines of 5 rounds)
- Targets            1 x Fig 12
- Scoring            5 & 4
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position, rifles loaded and made ready with safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds, firers are to adopt the prone position, release safety catches and open fire.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

**Stage 7 – 300-200x Rundown**

- Distance            300 & 200
- Position            Prone
- Rounds            10 to count
- Targets            1 x Fig 12 at 300x, 1 x Fig 12c at 200x
- Scoring            5 & 4
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position on the 300 yards firing point with rifles loaded and made ready with safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the Fig 12 target for fifteen seconds, firers are to adopt the prone position, release safety catches and fire two rounds.
  3. There will be two further exposures of 3 seconds, firers are to engage each exposure with one round. Firers will then be ordered to Make Safe.
  4. The 1 second 'flash' of the targets is the signal for firers to advance to the 200 yards firing point, adopt the prone position and make ready.
  5. 45 seconds later there will be six exposures of 3 seconds of a Fig 12c target over a 2m frontage. Firers are to fire one round per exposure.
  6. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

**Stage 8 - 200x Sitting**

- Distance            200 yards
- Position            Sitting
- Rounds            10 to count (two magazines of 5)
- Targets            1 x Fig 12
- Scoring            5 & 4
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position 3 yards behind the firing point with rifles loaded and safety catches applied.
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds, firers are to advance to the firing point, adopt the sitting position, make ready, release safety catches and open fire.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

### **Stage 9 - The 200-100x Assault**

- Distance            100 yards
- Position            Standing
- Rounds             10 to count
- Targets             1 x Fig 12c
- Scoring             5 & 4
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position on the 200 yards firing point with rifles loaded and safety catches applied.
  2. The 1 second 'flash' of the targets is the signal for firers to advance to the 100 yards firing point, adopt the standing position and make ready.
  3. 45 seconds later there will be three exposures of 8 seconds. Any number of rounds may be fired per exposure.
  4. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.

### **Stage 10 - The 100x Double Snap**

- Distance            100 yards
- Position            Kneeling and standing
- Rounds             10 to count
- Targets             1 x Fig 12c
- Scoring             5 & 4
- Procedure
  1. Firers will start in the standing alert position with rifles loaded and made ready.
  2. Targets will make five appearances of six seconds.
  3. On the first appearance of the targets, firers are to adopt the kneeling position and fire two rounds, remaining in the kneeling position.
  4. On the second appearance of the targets, firers are to adopt the standing position and fire two rounds, remaining in the standing position.
  5. On subsequent appearances of the targets, firers are to repeat this sequence until all ten rounds have been fired.
  6. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 30 seconds.
