

NRA 100 MATCH 2017

SUNDAY PM 29th OCTOBER

BISLEY CENTURY at 300yds not 200yds

Entries are invited to a unique Three Position Target Rifle Competition scored as 30 scoring shots x300.

The top 100 entrants receive an NRA 100 badge & date flash. Previous recipients of the NRA 100 badge receive a date flash, the winner a date & First flash & the Swanson Trophy. (2016 badges & bars will be available at the 2017 shoot).

The last few years entry has been less than 50, I am trying to get it above 70 even 100! & have 6 targets booked all day Sunday 23rd Oct at 200yds with permission for Standing & Kneeling (3P) shooting positions.



Cost of entry is £24 +own ammo. PM details. 4 per target it's not a rushed shoot.

Course of Fire: up to 4 non convertible sighters then 10 to count, at 300yds NRA Targets, in the order **Prone, Standing & then Kneeling / Sitting.**

Details: 1: 4 shooters prone, Detail 2: 2 shooters standing - assisted by the other non shooters (scope & plot fall of shot but NOT COACH). Detail 3: 2 shooters standing & as per detail 2, Detail 4: 2 shooters kneeling / Sitting, Detail 5: 2 shooters kneeling/sitting.

Scoring: – Normal target scoring - you must present your plot diagrams & scores to be officially entered. Your score will not be entered if not. 300yd x3 plot diagrams may be available to entrants on the day.

Equipment Control:–

Rifles & Ammo: Any Centre Fire Rifle & any CIP / Own / HL ammo. Normally 308/7.62 but people have shot with 5.56/.223/.38/303 & others.

No 0.22 rim fire or HME. No muzzle brakes. Iron sights only no scopes, no bipods or rests other than for loading.

Jackets etc: 3P shooting jackets / trousers, palm rests, lowered hand stops & kneeling rolls (log) are allowed.

Sling & glove are acceptable for Prone & Kneeling. No sling is to be used standing.

It is permissible to use a different compliant rifle for standing (e.g. No 4 303). A rest can be used for loading when standing / kneeling but not aiming or firing (camera tripod / stool / chair / Y stick - bring your own).

Tall spotting scope poles are advised.

Guest day of The North Herts Rifles

A limited number of Guests may shoot.

Guest must be accompanied by a full entrant who is Safe Shooter Certificated to supervise them. Guests must be FAC holders, members of the NRA or members of an NRA Affiliated club.


TNHR will not be providing any equipment, supervision or coaches for guest entrants.



Qualified RCOs may be asked to help RCO the range during Firing. Please advise if you are an RCO on entry. Any entrant may be asked to RCO supervise a 1-2FP's when not shooting.

The TNHR club makes no profit from this event. Entry covers range fees & marking, printing plot diagrams post & NRA prize badge costs.

TNHR will not provide ammo other than to members. NRA & Fultons have ammo for sale that can be used. Mixed / end of batch or mil-surp ammo is quite adequate for standing.

There will be a prize for entrants using Classic Service Rifles in all 3 positions. There are 48 entries available. First come first served.
