

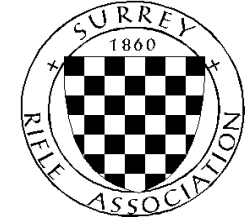
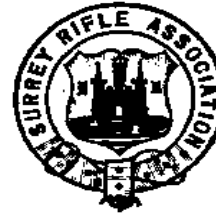
SRA Open Meeting 16th & 17th September 2017

Conditions of entry

1. Competitions are open to members of the NRA / any rifle club affiliated to the NRA, with the exception of any 'closed' Surrey competitions which are reserved for qualified competitors under Association rule 5(a) or 5(b) who are fully paid up members of the Surrey Rifle Association for the current year and who are eligible. Eligible members are defined as those who have not made themselves available for another county team in a representative match and have not shot in another county closed championship in the current year.
2. NRA regulations for the current year apply except where otherwise stated.
3. Only Target Rifles conforming to NRA TR specification may be used. All competitors are responsible for ensuring their rifles are properly zeroed prior to participating in the meeting and that their equipment conforms to NRA rules. The Surrey Rifle Association cannot accept any liability for a competitor using ammunition not suited to their rifle.
4. TR competitors may provide their own high quality .308/7.62mm caliber ammunition with a maximum bullet weight of 156 grain (select the '*excluding ammo*' figures in red on entry form). Ammunition can be provided by the Surrey Rifle Association upon request (select the '*including ammo*' figures in blue on the entry form).
5. Sighters are convertible for all competitions. If ammunition is supplied by the Surrey Rifle Association then all unused sighters and brass cases **MUST** be returned.
6. For first place in competitions with trophies, a tie shoot will take place where practical if two or more competitors have the same score. In prize lists, counting out will be as per current NRA rules, and then by class.
7. Squadding cards will be available from the Surrey Hut from 8pm on Friday 15th September. Ammunition may be collected on the day that it is to be used. Cards will only be issued on production of a valid Shooter Certification Card.
8. NRA TR class classifications for 2017 apply.
9. If an entry cannot be accepted, the applicant will be informed. Otherwise, no acknowledgement or receipt will be issued unless specifically requested and then, only when an email address is provided to the Secretary.
10. Full refund will be given for cancellations received prior to 1st September. Up to 50% refund may given thereafter at the discretion of the Committee. No-shows / late cancellations will incur their share of target, marker and other range fees unless the vacant slot can be filled by a replacement entry.
11. Ranges may not necessarily be shot in the order indicated on the program.
12. The Committee reserves the right to amend the format, rules and the prize lists according to the number of entries received. In the event of any dispute the Committee's decision is final.

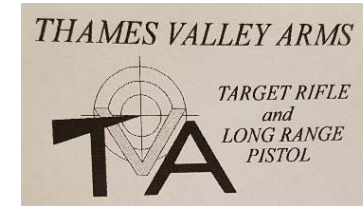
