Limited availability, only on the Sunday 0830 detail.

Re-entries are available on range. 6580 & 6590: £4. 6501: £3
- 4 6590: The McQueen (issued rifle)**
Using the NRA's Accuracy International AT rifles.
Ammunition to be purchased on range.
- 5 3521, 3524 & 3522: Practical Pistol Match & Round 4 of the NRA Handgun League**
This will be run on Sunday only on Stickle-down at Butt 0 in two Details – AM and PM.

- 6 3800: Man v Man**
This will be run on Saturday PM only on Stickle-down at Butt 0 from approximately 15.30.
- 7 UK Club Team Matches**
There are two matches for UK club teams of five. The best four scores will count. Please check the rules to make sure your team is eligible. The matches are aggregates of the Timed & Precision One and Multi-Target events. One match will be for GRSB and one for GRCF. Separate entry forms are attached and also available from Shooting Division and on the NRA website.

- 9 The Alan Whittle Novice Trophy**
This will be awarded to competitors who have not previously entered an open Meeting at Bisley or elsewhere. The winner will be whoever achieves the highest number of points in the standard medal scores system. See the Meeting Handbook for details of the scores you need to achieve in the individual events and how the points are awarded.
- 10 Entry Discounts**
* Under 25 years on the last day of the competition (Monday 29 May 2017) event fees are reduced by 40% – put your date of birth in the box on page 7

- * New to Bisley? If this is your first entry to the Phoenix Meeting or an NRA Action Weekend, fees are reduced by 30%.
- * If you enter six or more events, you can claim a discount of 10% on your total event fees, if you enter twelve or more the discount is 20% and twenty or more get a 25% discount.

ENTRY FORM NOTES

- Print your name and Gallery Rifle ID (permanent competitor number), if known, at the top of the first page.
- List your events in order of preference in the **PREF** column.
- Put an X in a **DAY** box for events you want to enter.
- Range Officers: if you can shoot events on the RO day, use the **RO** box.
- Put the fee in the **ENTRY FEE** column and calculate the total.
- Please be aware that should only one shooter enter a competition, in accordance with the NRA rules, no gold medal will be awarded.
- If you intend to use HME ammunition or a muzzle brake, please tick the box on page 3.
- Special requests: please attach a separate note for squadding together with **all** the entry forms.
- Complete page 6, sign & date the declaration and return the form with your payment (cheque payable to NRA with Phoenix 2017 on the reverse of the cheque) to:

Please send your entry form in early. Late entries make squadding and administration very difficult. Entry forms postmarked after 9th May will incur an additional fee of £1.00 per event entered. These entries may not benefit from advance squadding.

The GR&P Handbook will be available on line and at the Meeting. This Handbook contains the NRA rules, general conditions and event conditions for all GR&P Meetings. All GR&P Meeting organisers, range crew and competitors should be familiar with the contents.

It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA/NSC will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection. Please see the NRA policy statement on eye protection on the website.

It is a condition of entry that all competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested, e.g. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors.

The NRA reserves the right to refuse an entry.

PAYMENT DETAILS

Please make your cheque payable to 'NRA' and write 'PHOENIX 2017' on the reverse.

Entry fees will be refunded, less an administration fee of £5, if written notice is received at the NSC three weeks prior to the Meeting.

Any requests for refunds after this date are at the discretion of the Meeting Director.

CERTIFICATION

From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on an MoD range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club of which he is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Before being allowed to shoot, you must produce your SCC.

Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website.

DECLARATION - this MUST be signed by all competitors on Page 7

I declare that:

1. I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended).
2. I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential').
3. On the first day of the competition I will be aged fourteen years or over.
4. I meet at least one of the following conditions:
 - a. I hold a Firearm Certificate permitting me to use the firearms that I shall fire in this competition for target shooting.
 - b. I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club, will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended).
 - c. I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended).
5. I agree that results and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere. (Please note that only your name, competitor number, class and score will be posted).
6. I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Meeting and I will accept the decisions of the Meeting Director and the NRA as final.

HIGH MUZZLE ENERGY

Please tick the box if using HME ammunition.

You must follow the special zeroing procedure before collecting your scorecards in accordance with appendix VII of the NRA Handbook.

MUZZLE BRAKES

Please tick the box if using a muzzle brake.

This will help the range officers to try and ensure you are separated from other competitors.

**Practical Pistol Match Sunday 28 May 2017: Round 4 of the NRA
Handgun League**

Event 3521 **Open** - any .22 LBP with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.

Event 3524 **Standard** - any .22 LBP, holster and mag pouches to be worn behind the hip. Optical sights not permitted.

Event 3522 **Revolver Open:** any centre fire LBR with any sights, no restriction on holster or mag pouch location.

The match will have two Details:

Detail A will shoot AM between 08.30-12.00, Report Time 08.00

Detail B will shoot PM between 12.30-16.00, Report Time 11.30

You may be required to shoot through lunch.

If there is space you will be able to re-enter the event in a different division on the day.

Scoring will be in line with NRA and IPSC handbooks, you will require a minimum of 150 rds of ammunition. Targets will be from 2m to 35m and be a mixture of paper and steels. Competitors are required to assist with resetting/patching.

Safety catch - if fitted with a manual safety catch it must be fully functional.

Holster test - if your equipment fails the retention test you will start from the Tyro position where a holstered start is required. Shoulder and cross draw holsters are prohibited. The Match Director, James Harris, will be the final arbiter as to whether any holster or firearm may be used.

Tyro starts - persons not using a holster will be allowed to start in the Tyro position but will be subject to 1 procedural penalty per occurrence.

Standard and production guns required to fit IPSC Standard box (with allowance for extensions and barrels).
