

NRA 138th IMPERIAL MEETING INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FORM (TR & MR)

Saturday 14th to Saturday 28th July 2007

Before filling in this downloaded form, please consider entering online as this is a far easier way to enter the Imperial Meeting.

We would prefer competitors to enter online as the entry information from the website can then be imported directly into the Imperial Meeting squadding database which will result in more efficient processing of your entry. It is also far easier to enter the Imperial Meeting online as the entry form is much quicker to complete than the paper entry form and all the complicated sums are worked out for you.

In order to encourage competitors to enter online, there will be an additional Early Entry Online Draw for all entries over £100 received by Sunday 15 April. One prize of £100 will be awarded to one online entry drawn at random after the closing date. This prize is in addition to the usual Early Entry Draw which will occur as normal.

Registration

In order to enter the Imperial Meeting online, you will need to register as a user if you have not already done so (click on the Users drop-down menu at the top right hand side of the website). Once registered, the Membership Department will check your membership number and authorise your registration. Normally this check will take place during the next working day. If you are an NRA member please allow one working day for this to happen or else you will be charged a Meeting Membership fee which will be refunded when you collect your squadding cards.

Save Money!

This year Meeting Membership costs £40 for an adult. Full Individual Membership of the National Rifle Association now only costs £35 for your first years membership. Please read through these notes carefully before filling in the entry form.

Once you have completed this entry form please separate the two sections carefully along the perforations, return the entry form portion and keep these Notes for future reference. If you have any difficulties in completing this form please contact the Squadding Department which will be happy to help you.

1 Entering the Imperial Meeting

It is very much easier for you to enter the Imperial Meeting online at www.nra.org.uk rather than complete this paper entry form. In addition, entering via the website is much quicker, more accurate and more secure than a paper entry form and it will even work out all the complicated sums for you. You are therefore encouraged to use this form only for reference and to make your entry and pay securely online. A printed receipt will be posted to you in the normal way.

2 Completion of Entry Form

Please ensure that all details are completed carefully and legibly. If you have changed your name (eg by marriage), Club or Association please include a note to this effect so that we do not duplicate entries in the TR Class List or team records. Please include **all** your initials to ensure consistency in our computer records from year to year. If you are paying by credit card we must have your full billing address including postcode.

Please ensure that you complete **all** boxes in the top section of the form as these details are essential for the computer system. You may insert up to two Clubs, Primary (which will be the one shown on all prize lists) and Secondary (for use by team captains in selection). You should also state for which County and for which Country you are eligible to shoot. You **must** enter your date of birth in the box shown so that the correct entry fees can be calculated and you must sign the Certificate. Failure to do so may require the return of your entry form for correction.

3 Record of Rifles Used

GB competitors **must** record all details of the rifle(s) to be used during the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Please insert the type and serial number of the rifle(s) to be used. If necessary, please make an appropriate note and continue on a separate sheet. It is in your interests to record the use of **all** your firearms.

4 Classification of Competitors

Target Rifle Competitions	
X	Those whose names were published as Class X in the 2006 Prize List and nominated squad members of visiting teams eligible to compete in the Senior Kolapore.
A	Those whose names were published as Class A in the 2006 Prize List.
O	One who is not a Class X, Class A or Class T.
T	One whose name has never appeared in any Open Prize List relating to a TR competition included on this entry form above "Last O In". (But see Rule 14(b)).
F	All competitors using F Class rifles (Rule 164).
Note	Classes (other than X) of overseas competitors must be certified by their own NRAs. Class T status may not be claimed by adult overseas competitors.
Match Rifle Competitions	
O	One who is not Class T (MR).
T	One who has never appeared in the top 20 of the Hopton or in the top 10 in any other individual MR competition or who has never been Class X (TR).

In addition to entering your GB TR Class and (where applicable) MR Class, overseas competitors **only** should also insert their own **National** Classification in their own country.

5 F Class Competitions

This class will be open to those competitors who wish to use rifles which do not conform to the standard definition of TR in Rule 150. As defined in Rule 164 an F Class rifle may weigh up to 10 kg, and the trigger pull

may be unlimited **but must be safe**. The rifle may be fired from the prone or supine position, and may be used with telescopic sights and/or with a bipod or forward support. A rear butt support is also allowed, but **muzzle brakes are prohibited**. Calibres up to 8mm, but within the range safety limitations, may be used.

F Class competitors may supply their own ammunition or use the issued 5.56mm or 7.62mm. Special prizes will be awarded to those using the issued 7.62mm RG ammunition. If using their own ammunition they may reduce their TR entry fees by 25%. In this case all ammunition must comply with NRA Range Safety Regulations and conform to CIP standards.

The only aggregates open to F Class will be the Century Range and Stickle-down Range Aggregates and the Grand Aggregate; sweeps are not open to F Class. There will be an F Class Final in both the Queen's Prize and the St George's. Full definitions are published in the "Bisley Bible".

6 Membership of the NRA

Full NRA or Meeting Membership is a compulsory requirement for entry to any competition on this form. If you are **not** a current full member of the NRA please fill in the Meeting Membership box and pay the appropriate fee. If you would like to join the NRA as a full member please include a note to this effect and we will send you a membership pack.

Meeting Membership Rates

- £40 Entering TR or MR events and **not** eligible for concessions
- £20 Under 21, or Under 25 **and** undergoing full-time education
- Free Under 21, or Under 25 and undergoing full-time education, **and** entering the Meeting for the first time.

7 Markers

Paid markers will be provided for all competitions shown on this entry form. There will be no requirement for any competitors to butt mark in any matches shown overleaf. Please note that there is no option of electing to do butt marking to reduce your entry fees. TR entry fees do not include any form of marker fee. The marker fee per squadded TR competition will be £5.50 this year (£4.20 if under 21 or under 25 **and** undergoing full-time education). MR entry fees **include** marker fees.

8 Concessions/Discounts

- a Competitors who, on the last day of the Meeting, are under 21 years of age, or under 25 years of age and undergoing full-time education during the preceding term, may reduce their entry fees by 50% (except for markers and sweeps).
- b F Class competitors using own ammunition may reduce their TR entries by 25%. This deduction should be applied **before** any other concessions are deducted.

9 Chairman's Prize

This competition will be run under the same conditions as last year. The qualifying scores shall be those achieved in the Grand Aggregate including the Prince of Wales and the competition shall be open to the top 75 Class O and the top 75 Class T qualifiers **who have not qualified** for Queen's II. The qualifiers will shoot 2 sighters and 10 to count at 900 yards on Friday afternoon and at 300 and 600 yards on Saturday morning (HPS 150). Full details can be found in the Bisley Bible.

10 Aunts and Uncles Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, who would like to be mentored by an Aunt or Uncle (an experienced competitor who can help and advise you and assist with any shooting problems) should complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will then be contacted in due course with further details.

Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be an Aunt or Uncle, please contact the Squadding Department.
