

NOTES ON COMPLETION OF TEAM ENTRY FORM 2007

CLOSING TIMES FOR ENTRIES

Entries for all competitions listed overleaf (except for the Parting Shot, which will close at noon on Second Friday) will close at noon two days before the events are due to be shot, eg entries for the Astor, which is fired on First Friday, close at 12.00 noon on First Wednesday.

Late entries can only be accepted in exceptional circumstances, and will be subject to a 25% surcharge. In this event **markers may not be available**, and teams entering late must be prepared to provide their own. No refund will be allowable if this is the case.

No entry will be taken to have been made until full payment of the entrance fee and any necessary affiliation or late entry fees has been received.

MARKERS AND SPECIAL DUTIES

Markers will be provided for all squadded team matches shown overleaf. The fees for provision of butt markers have already been incorporated in the entry fees shown.

Teams may be required to provide Range Conducting Officers and/or Butts Officers, in which case Special Duty cards will be issued along with the team registers.
