



Team Journal – Part 5

Monday 16th August

Another blue-sky day as we left the hotel at 7.30 a.m. However, when we arrived at the range we found the camp blanketed in fog - so a delayed start. The wait was enlivened when the shopping detail returned with a battery powered mosquito-zapping racket. Jon Cload spent some time both inside and outside our hut, waving it around, delighted by the crackles it made as he took his revenge.



A visit to our pigeonhole at the stats office revealed that David Calvert had indeed won the **Macdougall**. Also within the top 10 of the list were Jon Underwood (5th), David Luckman (8th) and Our Captain (9th).

The final list for the **Gooderham** confirmed that Jon Underwood had won the Challenge Cup. In addition, to receive bronze medals in this competition are David Luckman, Toby Raincock and Martin Millar.



The fog soon lifted and shooting started precisely 43 minutes late - we were instructed that the 43 minute delay would be added to all detail times today. The morning was sunny and bright with a whisper of wind from the right at times. We shot the first stages of each of the Norman Beckett and the Col. J Brick - top scores on the morning were 50.9s from each of Our Captain, John Underwood and David Calvert.

At lunch time we had the competitors' photograph which, somewhat confusingly, had not been delayed by 43 minutes so that late arrivals continued to drift in over about 20 minutes allowing the mosquitoes a good opportunity for a feast - even though James Watson and Toby Raincock took turns with the zapper-racket.



After lunch we had the 800m of the Norman Beckett and the 600x of the Col. Brick (for those who have not been to Canada - the Canadians - at least in the shooting world - are more confused than us about Imperial/metric measurements - and they don't even have the excuse of Brussels). Conditions were much as yesterday: sunny, bright, warm and with only a gentle breeze from the right. There were at least two cross shots this afternoon - one onto (thankfully) this correspondent's target - and one (sadly) by Jane Messer who scored 45.3 at 800m with a nice v-bull sitting unhelpfully on the next-door target.



Great cheers went up as Our Vice-Captain returned triumphant from the 600x range, having bagged a 50.5.

At the end of the day there were two team members who have gone clean in the **Macdonald Stewart Grand Agg** - David Luckman with 300.41 and, a mere 1 v-bull behind, Jon Underwood.

In the **Norman Beckett** five of the team had possibles: Nigel Ball (100.17), David Luckman (100.15), Parag Patel (100.13), Jon Underwood (100.13) and James Watson (100.8).

This achievement was surpassed in the **Col J Brick**, in which there were 7 possibles - leading the pack was Our Captain (100.16), followed by David Calvert (100.15) David Luckman (100.13) Jon Underwood (100.13) Andy Luckman (100.11), Jane Messer (100.11) and James Lewis (100.7).
