



Team Journal – Part 6

Tuesday 17th August



Last night the team split into three foraging parties with two heading to fish restaurants (one in downtown Ottawa and one close by the hotel) and the third, younger, group going to somewhere altogether more basic (apparently, something concerning owl watching).

Today was the equivalent of Bisley's Queens I day - 7 at 300m, 500x and 600x and 10 at 900m. In addition there was a coached pairs match - 10 at 900m. We arrived at the range this morning to find a benign scene. Dry, part cloud cover - not so bright, and with the flags drooping lazily against their poles.

Stats this morning told what is now becoming a consistently happy tale. The two top places in the **Grand Agg** are currently being held by David Luckman (300.41) and Jon Underwood (300.40). Also in the top ten are David Calvert (4th) and Our Captain (9th).

Nigel Ball won the **Norman Beckett** with 100.17, from Jim Paton of BC with 100.15. The top ten places also held David Luckman (4th) and Parag Patel (9th).

In the **Col. Brick** (which was won by Bryan Kaufman of Ontario) we had 2nd place (the Captain), 4th place (David Calvert) and 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th places (David Luckman, Jon Underwood, Jane Messer and Andy Luckman).

The finalised list for the **Tilton** confirmed that Toby Raincock won the Gold Medal with David Calvert taking silver and David Luckman, Parag Patel, James Watson and Jon Underwood being awarded bronze medals.



For the Coaches' Match, shot at 1.00, the authorities had arranged for the wind to become interesting - with up to 10 minutes of left wind on at 900m. The preliminary results, as announced on the range, were that both first and second places went to GBRT coaches with the Vice-Captain (coaching Parag 50.2 and Toby 49.6 = 99.8) edging out Jane (coaching Jon 50.6 and Alistair 48.5 = 98.11).



The **Tunis** has the reputation, like our own Corporation, of being an agg killer - the Captain's record over his last 4 attempts was 28, 38, 40, 44. He came back today a very happy (and, as can be seen, a very hot) Captain with a 50.5.



Meanwhile, our hut rang to the sound of hammering as our Armourer and Assistant Armourer showed solidarity with the Athelings by rebedding one of their rifles. The GB flag shows a brisk breeze still blowing at 5 p.m.

The end-of-the-day round-up of results show that the GB team is continuing its very satisfactory progress through the meeting. David Luckman is thought to be the winner of the **Klondike Agg** (the Grand Agg to date), having dropped only 1 point since the Grand started on Sunday at lunch time. Our Captain now lies only 1 point behind David, David Calvert and Jon Underwood are 1 point behind the Captain and Andy Luckman and Mary Boston follow 1 and 2 points, respectively, behind Jon.

We had 4 team members who went clean in the **Letson** - David Luckman, Mary Boston, James Lewis and David Richards.

Two of the team had possibles in the **Alexander of Tunis** - the Captain and Alwyn McLean.

This, very sunny, evening we are eating on the range - a corn roast - details to follow tomorrow
